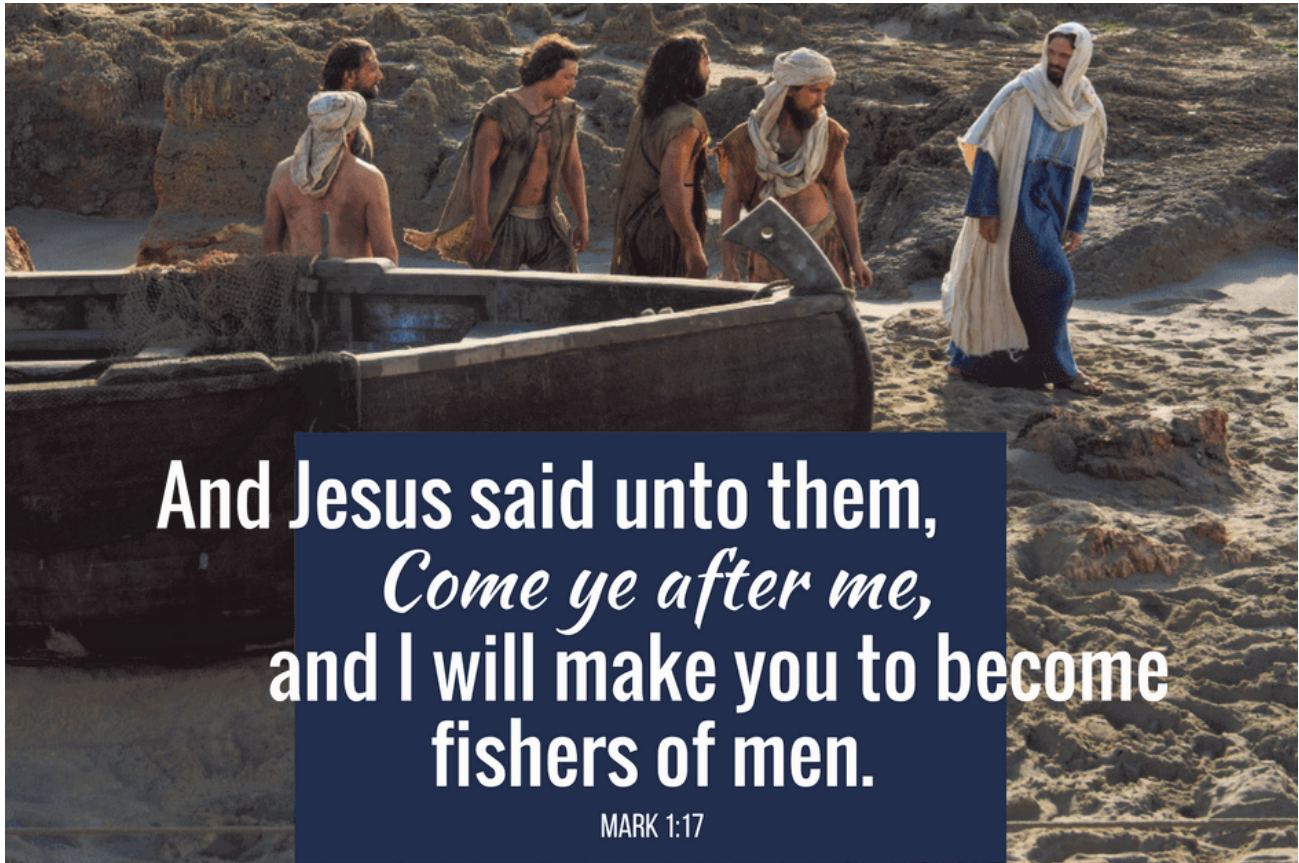

Hello Pro-Life Friends at St. Ephrem!

We are getting excited here at the Legacy of Life Foundation for the upcoming Baby Bottle Drive happening at your parish on January 30th & 31st. Last year hundreds of women in crisis knocked on our doors and 360 babies were saved - including 3 sets of twins and one set of triplets! To keep everyone safe we made some modifications to the Baby Bottle Drive. Instead of passing out the baby bottles we will be using envelopes with a baby bottle on the front. Look for the envelopes to be given out after masses the weekend of January 30th & 31st. Volunteers will be following CDC guidelines with masks and gloves.

2. dropping it in one of the plastic tote bags held by a volunteer at each door

“Lord Teach Us How to Pray”

A mother's child is ill. She doesn't want him to die, but the doctor told her, "I've tried absolutely everything. All we can do now is resign ourselves to the inevitable." But the mom neither believed the doctor nor listened to her husband as he tried to reason with her. Instead, she told both of them what she thought: "You're giving up too easily; but I won't abandon my son like you, because I'm sure he can still be saved." So here she is in church. She has come to tell God that her boy mustn't die, that he simply can't, that she doesn't want him to, that God couldn't permit such a thing. Then, by dint of praying—if she does it sincerely and long enough—she enters into a deeper prayer. Slowly, the detachment she rules out begins to permeate her; and when she gets up, she's amazed to hear herself say, "Lord, I entrust him to you. From this moment on, he's your child much more than mine. I know he's better off in your hands. You're responsible for him now, and you'll take better care of him than I ever could. May your will be done."

Father Everly comments: "Jesus himself prayed that way. At first he pleaded, 'Father, everything is possible for you. Take this cup away from me.' Then, because he stayed the whole night through, he entered into a deeper prayer and arose saying, 'Let your will be done, not mine.'"

Everly concludes his story by saying: "If we try to pray like that, if we try to submit to this transforming power, we'll feel our earlier attitude change under the spell of prayer. We come weighed down with burdens, crushed under mountains of care, resentment, sadness, obsession and fear. Never could we lift them, never free ourselves. We're everlastingly pinned to the ground. And then, as we pray, God slowly rises up, manifests himself and starts to act. God becomes God before our eyes... When God becomes God in our life, everything changes and yet remains the same; all questions are answered and all our ills healed solely because God has resumed his rightful place and we've returned to ours."

However, after further review, we have again decided to postpone the RCIA classes until September 2021. Archdiocese Announces New Information on Church Annulments

At the request of Pope Francis, there will NO longer be a charge for any marriage annulment through the Marriage Tribunal at the Archdiocese of Philadelphia.

This new policy covers "long" annulments, that can cost from \$300.00 to \$850.00, and "simple" annulments that cost \$50.00 and are handled by the parish priest.
