Archdiocese Announces New Information on Church Annulments

At the request of Pope Francis, there will NO longer be a charge for any marriage annulment through the Marriage Tribunal at the Archdiocese of Philadelphia. This new policy covers “long” annulments, that can cost from \$300.00 to \$850.00, and “simple” annulments that cost \$50.00 and are handled by the parish priest. If you are not sure whether or not you need a church annulment, or you have any other questions, please do not hesitate to call the rectory or speak to one of our priests.

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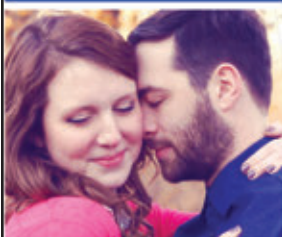
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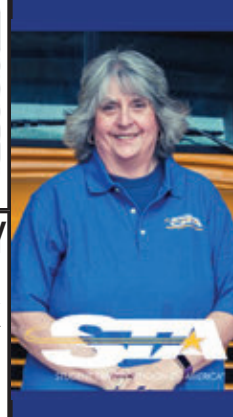
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
