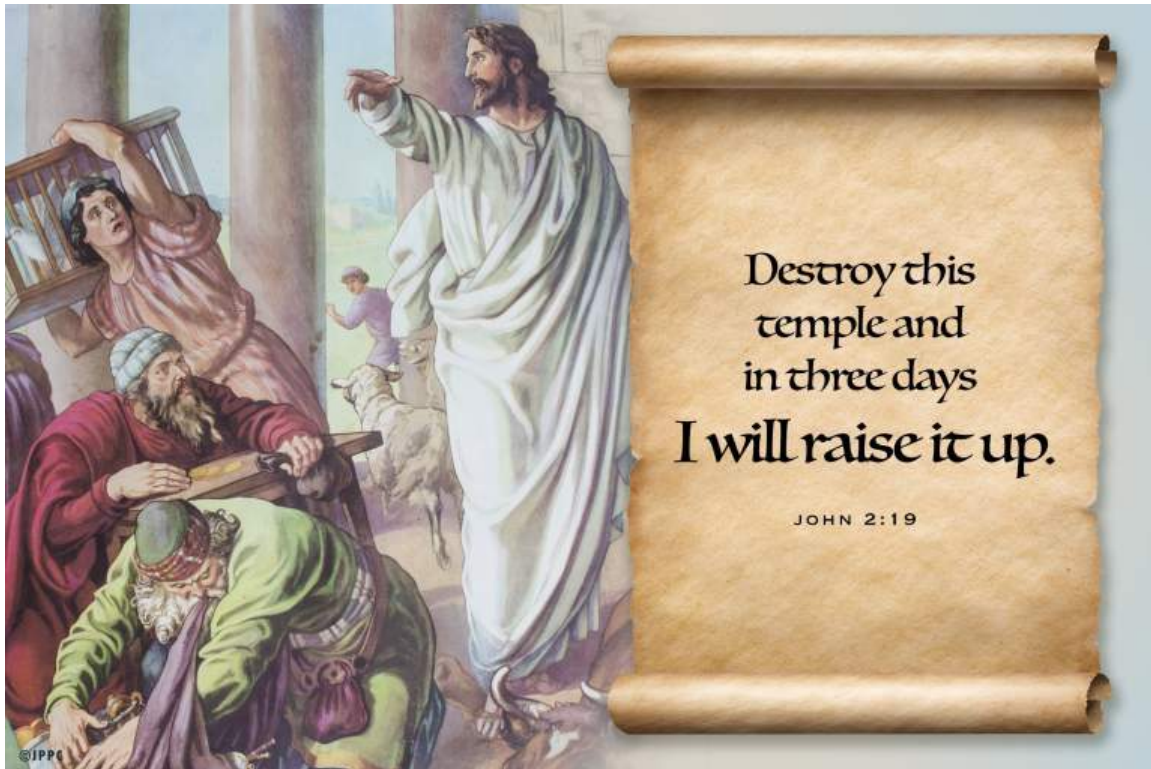

#### AN UPDATE ON FATHER O'SULLIVAN

Dear Friends,

This Monday, March 4th, will be the two-month anniversary of my double-kidney transplant surgery. These last eight and a half weeks, as you can imagine, have been filled with many 'ups and downs'; but, thanks be to God, there have been more 'ups' than there have been 'downs'. (But I must say, the transplant process has been much more complex than I ever realized it would be.)

The most significant 'up' in my recovery has been that my body has not rejected my new kidneys! (My doctors believe that if a transplant recipient gets through the first month, the odds of rejection diminish greatly.) As a matter of fact, my new kidneys show significant signs of 'waking up' – although they are not 100% functioning.... yet. My last dialysis treatment was on January 18th; since then, my new kidneys have been doing the work.

The second significant 'up' of my recovery has been my creatinine level. The key factor which determines the proper functioning of the kidneys is the creatinine level in urine. (Creatinine is a protein that is filtered out of the body through the kidneys. Ideally a good creatinine level is 1.0–1.5.) Before my transplant surgery, my creatinine level was 8.0! (A person is usually put on dialysis if their creatinine level shows an increasing trend and passes 2.5-3.0.) My current creatinine level is 1.7.

Probably the most significant 'down' of my recovery was an unexpected six-day hospital stay to address excessive fluid that medications could not remove from my body. At the beginning of my recovery, my doctors told me that I needed to drink a lot of water to keep the new kidneys hydrated, as well as force the new kidneys to work. Unfortunately, the excessive fluid build-up in my body was affecting my breathing; with no activity my breathing was labored; with relatively small amounts of activity (walking up a flight of stairs), my breathing was severely affected. During the hospital stay, they were able to remove almost thirty pounds of fluid! Excessive fluid is still a concern, but nothing like it was! Increased medications are helping to get my breathing back to normal.

Immediately following my surgery, I was placed on eighteen new prescriptions! I remember looking at the pharmacy technician and saying, "You are kidding, right?"... No! He was not. I have since been taken off two of them (take small victories when you can!) and anticipate discontinuing another four or five within the next six weeks or so, depending on my blood work results; but several of these prescriptions will be perpetual.

Now that I am somewhat recovered, I am getting a bit fidgety and wanting my life to get 'back to normal'. However, weekly blood labs and weekly doctors' appointments keep me in New York. My last scheduled weekly doctors' appointment is April 17th, so, barring any unforeseen complications, I anticipate returning to St. Ephrem's in mid-April. I rely on your continued prayers to help bring this to fruition.
